YEAR 7-10 DROP-IN HOMEWORK HUB 2023

Dear Parent/Guardian.

The Winmalee High School Learning Hub will again be facilitating a weekly homework program to be run on Monday afternoons from 2.45pm - 3.45pm. The program will commence in Week 4 of Term 1 (13th February). This program will take place in the Learning Hub and be supervised by Mrs Shead, Ms Doyle and Ms Hinchey Holley, the Learning Hub and Learning Support teachers. The aim of the program is to offer a 'drop-in' space for Year 7-10 students so they may establish skills in areas of need or receive assistance with homework and assessment tasks. This activity is designed for students who are able to undertake independent work.

As part of the program, students will also be given strategies and skills to manage their time, stress and organisation skills.

At the end of each session, students will be dismissed from the Learning Hub by the supervising teachers and be expected to immediately make their way to their designated transport home.

Positive outcomes from the program may include:

- Learning support
- Engaging and motivating students to persevere with set work
- Learning to manage stress using simple tools
- Providing an opportunity for deliberate practice
- Providing an opportunity to accept and apply feedback
- Providing an opportunity to establish new relationships in an inclusive and supportive environment

If you would like your child to attend this program, please send a permission note with your child, allowing them to access the Learning Hub between 2.45pm and 3.45pm on Mondays.

Please note: The permission note does not require your child to attend every week, only the weeks the student feels they need to attend.
