Dear Parents and carers,

Welcome to the end of Week 7 and the beginning of the long weekend. We hope you have something nice planned!

ADFAS Grant – Last year, The School of Arts Wentworth Falls ADFAS (Australian Decorative Fine Arts Societies) generously provided Winmalee High School with a grant of \$1500 to support Music programs at our school, post the disruptions of COVID-19. This year, we have finally been able to use this support to revive our Vocal Groups. This grant has funded the vocal programs that Mrs Clifford leads, and students have not needed to pay fees related to this co-curricular program. Sentral Parent Portal

Thank you to parents for their positive feedback on the Sentral Parent Portal. We hope it is making a difference with accessing important school information. Below is information about how to access the portal, and details about what you can access once you are set up, just in case you missed this or haven't had a chance to get started with this.

Parents:

Download Sentral for Parents app from <u>Apple App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u> **OR** access via <u>winmaleehs.sentral.com.au/portal2</u>, create an account using a valid email address and then access your child's/children's information via the Access Key that was emailed separately at the end of April.

Please contact the office if you require a second Access Key for an additional parent.

A link to the Portal is also available on the Winmalee High School website homepage.

From the Portal, parents can access

- Student timetable/s
- School calendar
- Daily notices
- Absence information and submit absence explanations
- Assessment tasks and notes for excursions and school activities
- Weekly Community Communication
- School reports from end of Semester 1 2022
- Links to WHS Website, Uniform Shop & Facebook.





Students are also able to access the Student Portal via the same URL using their det log in information: <u>winmaleehs.sentral.com.au/portal2</u>

Note: Students do NOT need (and are unable to use) the Sentral for Parents app.

When a student logs in using their usual det login and password, their 'menu' options are:

- Dashboard (shows daily notices, timetable for that day, and links to Newsletters, WHS Website, Uniform Shop & WHS Facebook)

- Timetable (full) - they can also export their calendar as an iCal file from here as well as print it from here in 'Complete', 'Simple' and 'Compact' formats.

- Resources (folders for each year group containing notes and Assessment Tasks, as well as folders for School Communications, Duke of Edinburgh and Sport).

We will help students over the next few weeks to access the student portal, so they are familiar with the process.

Student Toilets – this week, the P&C moved a motion to commit funds for the school to purchase vape detectors for student toilets. The school will work closely with the P&C and SRC to implement this initiative. Coupled with further education about vaping, we hope this makes a difference to our students. Survey results and our next steps are still being considered. We would like to thank the P&C for their continued support for practical resources which support our students.

We would like to wish all our dancers the best of luck as they perform for another week at the **Synergy Dance Festival** in Week 8. To have almost 50 students participate in this event is just wonderful and we look forward to congratulating all students and sharing some images with you.
